2024 Santa Barbara International Orchid Show Juried Art and Photography Exhibit (Class 25)

in conjunction with Santa Barbara Art Association

Eligibility

Open to all artists, photographers, and fine quality artisans. All works must feature orchids as their primary subject matter. All works must be executed by the exhibitor and the work may not have been entered in a previous Santa Barbara International Orchid Show. Entries are limited to three (3) per exhibitor. The Show Committee reserves the right to exclude any work for any reason, including failure of the exhibitor to comply with the Show Rules and Regulations.

Registration

- Artists must submit a Request to Exhibit Form, filled out online, indicating the number of pieces they wish to exhibit. Titles and/or prices will be determined by the artist at the ingathering. The form may be found at https://sborchidshow.com/artwork-and-photography-exhibit-application-2024/
- REQUEST TO EXHIBIT FORM(s) must be submitted by February 21, 2024 and each entry accompanied by a \$10 fee. No Request to Exhibit Form(s) WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE—NO LATE ENTRIES!
- Artwork and photography will be accepted at the Earl Warren Showgrounds on Wednesday, March 6, 2024 from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM.
- All artists must return to the Showgrounds between 3:00 PM and 4:00 PM on Wednesday, March 6, 2024 to claim art or photography not chosen for exhibit by the judges; artists will be telephoned if their work is not juried into the show.
- All artwork must remain in place until after the close of show on Sunday, March 10, 2024, at 5:00 PM, BUT MUST BE PICKED UP BY 6:15 PM. For security of the artwork, photo identification will be required to pick up artwork.

Preparation

- An entry may not exceed 36 inches in any direction without special permission from the Santa Barbara International Orchid Show.
- Work to be hung must have wire for hanging. (No sawtooths.)
- Labels for each artwork or photograph will be filled out at the ingathering.

Sale(s) of Artwork or Photography

Artists may offer their exhibited works for sale. Pricing must be provided at the ingathering. The Santa Barbara International Orchid Show will collect funds for any work sold during the show weekend. A 35% commission is to be remitted to the Santa Barbara International Orchid Show before release of funds from sale(s).

Liability

Reasonable care will be taken with each work submitted and displayed. The Santa Barbara International Orchid Show, its officers and employees, and the Santa Barbara Art Association cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to any piece of art or any part of an exhibit. Private insurance is recommended for valuable works. Private insurers are welcome to check the Santa Barbara International Orchid Show's security measures. The Request TO Exhibit Form constitutes agreement with these Rules and Regulations, including this paragraph.
